



CTCA Training Guidelines as of 1st July 2024	
Initial certification	
Level A	<p>Pathway 1 Logbook of 150 cases total - 50 live cases (supervised by a level B). Please note that cases undertaken within a course are not to be included + 100 library cases (breakdown of non-coronary cardiac findings, correlated and, noncardiac findings).</p> <p>All Logbook cases must be supervised by a Level B CTCA Specialist (See the Register for full list of Level B Specialists)</p> <p>Pathway 2 Completion of a cardiac imaging Fellowship (post FRANZCR or FRACP) at an accredited training site for a minimum of 1 year. This would include 40 hours of didactic learning, minimum of 3 months of cardiac CT. Minimum of 20 hours of hands-on training and remaining hours are theory.</p>
Level B	<p>Pathway 1 3 years certified at level A.</p> <p>Pathway 2 Completion of a cardiac imaging Fellowship (post FRANZCR or FRACP) at an accredited training site for a minimum of 1 year. This would include 40 hours of didactic learning, minimum of 3 months of cardiac CT. Minimum of 20 hours of hands-on training and remaining hours are theory.</p>
Recertification	
Level A	<p>Retain Level A status: Cycle 1 and 2: More than 150 cases over 3 years + 4 hours of cardiac imaging CPD per year in a minimum of 2 out of 3 CPD categories.</p> <p>Cycle 3 (9th year) Signed statement declaring still active in reporting CTCA + 4 hours of cardiac imaging CPD per year in a minimum of 2 out of 3 CPD categories</p>
Level B	<p>Retain Level B status: Signed statement declaring more than 300 cases over 3 years + 6 hours of cardiac imaging CPD per year in a minimum of 2 out of 3 CPD categories</p>
